Explanation

DEFINITION OF DOWNLOAD AND UPLOAD

Download and Upload are generic terms in the insurance and computer industry which have taken on many meanings.

Within the insurance industry's interface context, download is most often used as a synonym for "batch-back." Data contained in Insurance House's computer(s) is transmitted to the agency computer to update the agency database.

Upload is sometimes referred to as "batch-in." It is the reverse of Download. Data entered into the agency computer is sometimes edited through software incorporated into your agency computer system, such as the WebSEMCI software or the Applied Systems Forms/Interface Module. The data is then transmitted to Insurance House's computer for processing through the policy writing system to rate the policy and issue the declarations.

BENEFITS OF DOWNLOAD

- Eliminates redundant data entry for your agency by allowing all new business, renewals, endorsements, and cancellations/reinstatements from Insurance House to automatically update your database on an ongoing basis.
- Matches your agency's database to the Insurance House database providing more accurate information while preserving the integrity of your agency data.
- Proven way for agencies to quickly, efficiently, and accurately build a policy data base. This is accomplished by daily additions of new business, renewals, endorsements and cancellations/reinstatements to your agency file as these transactions occur from the Insurance House host system.

BENEFITS OF UPLOAD

- As with download, upload also eliminates redundant data entry for your agency by allowing one system to be used for many insurance companies. There is no need for the agency to maintain separate computer systems for each insurance company you do business with.
- Reduces training time and expense as well as reducing cost of mailing paper applications. Agency personnel need only be trained on one system.
- Data is more accurate since the agency system is the original source of the new business data. Sending the data to Insurance House directly from the source reduces subsequent phone calls to verify incorrect or missing data later. Policy issuance occurs more quickly.

CHALLENGES

- For your agency to take advantage of the data download/upload company interface, you must first have an agency management system that is capable of receiving data that Insurance House has formatted into the industry standard ACORD Automation Level III (AL3) format and sending data in the same format.
- Secondly, your agency system must be able to connect to the mailbox, either on the IVANS Ecommerce Server (ECS) or via the IBM Information Exchange (IE), using communications software, such as IVANS Transfer Manager or Expedite.
- Currently, many transactions are being exchanged between carrier and agency in "real time" using IVANS Transformation Station, which is supported by many of the agency management systems.
